

Neighborhood Mediation Center Annual Report 7/1/18 - 6/30/19

Mediation Case Statistics

Fiscal year–end is 6/30/19. NMC handled 435 cases during the fiscal year, including 409 mediated cases and 26 case intakes that did not result in mediation; mediated cases reaching agreement = 202 - resolution rate 49.4%.

Volunteers

Volunteer mediators donated 886 hours of their time in mediation and an additional 50 hours assisting staff with the mediation program for a total of 936 hours. **THANK YOU!**

Training and Development

- NMC provided 40 hours of Beginning Mediation training to a class of 14
- NMC provided 24 hours of Advanced Mediation training to a class of 8
- NMC provided 6 hours of Conflict Resolution and De-escalation Skills training to 65 participants
- NMC provided 4 hours of in-service training to 18 volunteer mediators
- NMC staff and court coordinators conducted approximately 90 hours of debrief with volunteer mediators
- NMC provided approximately 75 hours of mentoring to 5 new volunteer mediators
- Staff attended advanced trainings at: Center for Understanding in Conflict, Mill Valley, CA; Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution, Pepperdine; "ToP" training through Institute of Cultural Affairs
- Staff and volunteers attended 6-hour advanced mediation training through NDRC

- NMC continues to mediate complex Temporary Protective Order cases as referred
- NMC continues to collaborate with a variety of City and County agencies on referrals to mediation
- NMC continues to collaborate with the Northern Nevada International Center (NNIC) to expose travelling delegations to mediation as an alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process
