

Neighborhood Mediation Center Annual Report 7/1/19 - 6/30/20

Mediation Case Statistics

Fiscal year–end is 6/30/20. NMC handled 370 cases during the fiscal year, including 352 mediated cases and 18 case intakes that did not result in mediation; mediated cases reaching agreement = 159 - resolution rate 45.2%. (Due to the COVID-19 pandemic outbreak, NMC's services to local courts were suspended for a period of approximately 7 weeks from March to May 2020 which resulted in a lower than average total case count for the fiscal year.)

Volunteers

Volunteer mediators donated 860.5 hours of their time in mediation and an additional 50 hours assisting staff with the mediation program for a total of 910.5 hours. **THANK YOU!**

Training and Development

- NMC scheduled to offer 40-Hour Beginning Mediation training in April 2020 cancelled due to COVID-19.
- NMC provided 4 hours of in-service training to 20 volunteer mediators.
- NMC staff and court coordinators conducted approximately 103 hours of debrief with volunteer mediators.
- NMC provided approximately 72 hours of mentoring to 6 new volunteer mediators.
- Staff attended advanced trainings at: Straus Institute for Dispute Resolution, Pepperdine; American Management Association, San Diego; and various 1-2 hour online training webinars.

Community

- NMC continues to mediate complex Temporary Protective Order cases as referred by the courts.
- NMC continues to collaborate with a variety of City and County agencies on referrals to mediation.
- NMC continues to collaborate with the Northern Nevada International Center (NNIC) to expose travelling delegations to mediation as an alternative dispute resolution (ADR) process.
- NMC provides Conflict Resolution Skills workshops to community organizations and businesses on request.
